Ten Item Continuous Story...

How to use this exercise:

This exercise helps teach continuity and cooperation.

Gather any 10 to 15 random items and give one to each child. Then move around the table. Each child has to make up a short story about their item. The next child must continue the story with his or her item to form a continuous story.

When you you've gone around once then hand out the items in a different order and choose students randomly.

The goal is get them to work together and learn to engage in creative dialogue.

Example Items we Have Used

- Tractor
- Protractor
- Tissue box (that looked like an Easter Island statue)
- Antique shoe stretcher
- Old music box
- A battery powered jumping dog
- A stuffed animal
- A book
- A bunch of hats
- A small toaster
- Etc.
