Part A:

Materials:

- 2 sheets of plain white printing paper
- Different colored markers/colored pencils

Directions:

You will have **2 minutes** to draw a hand held item on each piece of paper (*Ex/ flashlight, frying pan, camera, or necklace*). Each piece of paper should have a different item drawn on it.

Scoring:

10 points for the creativity of the objects

10 points for the creative way in which you drew your items

10 points for teamwork

Part B:

Materials:

The 2 papers you drew items on.

One more item

Directions:

You will have **4 minutes** to come up with a skit. You will use your 2 papers as props, but not as paper. Now these are whatever you drew on the paper. The papers cannot be ripped or altered in anyway. In addition to your pretend/paper props, you will have another item that will be given to you. This is another prop that must be included in your presentation.

Scoring:

Up to 10 points for team work

Up to 15 points for creative use of paper props

Up to 15 points for creative use of real prop

Up to 8 points for the creative way props are integrated into the story

Up to 8 points for the quality of your skit (smoothness, story, characters)

Up to 10 points for the creativity of your story

Up to 5 points for every full minute of your skit
